SolstadFarstad operates in a vulnerable marine environment, we are therefore committed to protecting and promoting this environment in all aspects of our operations to conserve and enhance environmental resources for future generations.

This Policy applies to all areas of SolstadFarstad operations.

At SolstadFarstad we shall:

- Strive to be a market leader of environmentally friendly offshore shipping services through innovation, professionalism and continuous focus on environmental related aspects of all parts of SolstadFarstad's operations;
- Support the company environmental program Solstad Green Operations (SGO) by combining our employee's knowledge with advanced technology to reduce fuel consumption and emissions;
- Involve employees, suppliers and clients in raising environmental awareness;
- Integrate sound environmental practices into all aspects of operations, thereby offering competitive and technologically innovate shipping services;
- Strive for continuous improvement in our environmental performance by continuous monitoring, analysis of environmental key indicators and open communication with all stakeholders.
- Aim to prevent pollution thereby minimizing the impact of our activities on the environment;
- Continuously strive to reduce and optimize consumption of fuel and energy and thereby emissions to air;
- Ensure that waste generation is minimised and that all waste is segregated before delivery to the onshore receiving facility;
- Ensure that no waste except food waste is discharged to sea;
- Improve on design, management and operation of vessels and facilities to promote energy efficiency, increase waste recycling and prevent harmful discharges;
- Promote that vessel being sold to another company or intermediary with the intention of being scrapped, is recycled at a recycling yard, which conducts its recycling business in a socially and environmentally responsible manner under Hong Kong International Convention for the Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships, 2009 and/or EU Ship regulation.
- Aim to achieve higher environmental standards than the minimum legislative requirements through cooperation with clients and suppliers in the application of the latest developments in environmental knowledge;

Handle waste accordance with the principles in MARPOL 73/78, IMO ISM Code and with the national and international rules and regulations.

Responsibility and Accountability:

The CEO has ultimate accountability and an active and leading role for ensuring this policy is implemented on all levels of the organization through demonstrated leadership and the provision and availability of the necessary resources.

All SolstadFarstad employees, subcontractor employees, clients and visitors have an individual responsibility to ensure that their work has a minimal impact to the environment and to work together as a team to achieve this policy.
